Our print committee takes pride in handling your prints and protects them from the elements, however, when rules are not followed damage may occur.

Several prints were received with Velcro adhesive fasteners on the backside leaving the committee with a decision on disqualifying or removing the fasteners. When removing fasteners or tape a sticky area on the mat remains and can damage your print or any other print coming in contact. We will remove prints from competition when we find any sticky material during the pre-prep.

During normal handling of a three board matting system, several of the back mat boards separated due to inadequate bonding. Do not expect one or two pieces of double back masking tape to maintain the integrity during normal critique handling.

During the pre-prep of prints our committee had to disqualify one print for incorrect mat size.
