## When and Why should I use the 4800

- Large Prints
- 16" by 49'
- Thick Media
- Can print without bending the media
- Up to $1.5 \mathrm{~mm}, .059$ "
- Cost
- $\$ 0.12$ per inch(two $8 \times 10$ prints side by side $=\$ 1.20$ )
- Costco two 8"x10" \$1.49 ea = \$2.98
